- Reports to the Club Head Coach.
- Designs and implements swim practice plans.

- Communicates regularly with junior parents and forwards parent concerns to Club Head Coach.
- Attends coach meetings.
- Performs various clerical duties on digital platforms such as maintaining attendance and progress reports.
- Responsible for the overall safety of junior members during training and at tournaments/games.
- Assists in the supervision of the use, safety, and storage of FVWP equipment.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops that may be available.
- Attends local junior competitions.
- Participates in community outreach activities.
- Assists and supports all team-related activities, fundraisers etc.
- Acts in accordance with the WPC Code of Ethics.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
