

Allergy Aware Policy for FVWPC

At least one child registered with Fraser Valley Water Polo has a life threatening Peanut Allergy.

We are asking for your cooperation in making FVWPC a safe environment for all athletes with life threatening allergies. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but we ask you to not bring peanut products to practices or tournaments.

The Club cannot “ban” peanut products or other allergens, and we do not want to mislead anyone by calling Fraser Valley Water Polo Club Peanut Free. We practice in public pools with members of the public present and in tournaments with athletes and family members present, and we stay in hotels and eat in restaurants, all places where we are unable to have any control over allergens.

Once a life-threatening allergy has been reported to the team manager by the parents, the team manager will inform the rest of the team parents by email. The parents of the child with the allergy will discuss the needs of their athlete with the tournament director and make arrangements they see as necessary for their athlete to participate in travel with the team.

We thank you for your cooperation to not bring peanut products to the pool or tournaments.
